PROJECT OVERVIEW

This \$60M project consisted of widening approximately one mile of US 101 from Milpas Street to Hot Springs Road. This area of US 101, the main route through Santa Barbara County, had been a cause of traffic congestion and major commuter delays for many years before the project began.

Construction occurred in four stages over three years.

Construction elements included: Four new bridges and a bridge system; approximately six miles of retaining and sound walls; over 65,000 cubic meters of earthwork; construction and reconstruction of on and off ramps;

construction of a new roundabout; box culverts and multiple drainage structures; signals and lighting; paving; and significant traffic control.
